| Tasting Notes | The inky purple 2017 Wight Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon boasts layers of black cherry, graphite, and smoke. Dense, rich fruit is balanced with rounded tannins and full-bodied texture. This 2017s are bright and balanced, with plenty of structure behind their lush Lewelling Ranch fruit. We were fortunate to have picked many days before the tragic fires of 2017 and capture the purity of the vintage. |
