## 2018 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

<b>Appellation</b>	Napa Valley
<b>Vineyard Site</b>	1/2 mile south of St. Helena on Lewelling Lane, an alluvial fan at the base of the western foothills
<b>Soil</b>	Bale gravelly loam
<b>Vines</b>	Cabernet Sauvignon on 110R rootstock
<b>Trellis</b>	Vertical, 7-wire; 5' x 9' vine spacing; cane pruned
<b>Composition</b>	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
<b>Case Production</b>	950 cases
<b>pH</b>	3.80
<b>TA (g/100ml)</b>	0.54
<b>Harvest Date</b>	October, 15 & 19, 2018
<b>Brix at Harvest</b>	25.6
<b>Aging</b>	2 months in 70% new French oak barrels
<b>Finishing</b>	Bottled unfinned and filtered on May, 2020
<b>Release Date</b>	September 15, 2021
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	The 2018 Lewelling Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon is emboldened by dark berries, which meld easily with sweet vanilla, rose petal, and licorice. On the darker end of the fruit spectrum and with substantial but gentle oak tannin, the 2018 has a lasting sway. This enticing wine impresses the mid-palate and might prove to be a vintage for the ages.
