<b>Vineyard Site</b>	1/2 mile south of St. Helena on Lewelling Lane, an alluvial fan at the base of the western foothills
<b>Soil</b>	Bale gravelly loam
<b>Vines</b>	Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc on 110R rootstock
<b>Trellis</b>	Vertical, 7-wire; 5' x 9' vine spacing; cane pruned
<b>Composition</b>	95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc
<b>Case Production</b>	791 cases
<b>Alcohol</b>	15.3%

<b>Tasting Notes</b>	<p>Bouquet - a bright bouquet of wild black raspberry, dark plum, and Rainier cherry joined by vanilla, sweet tobacco and new saddle leather.</p> <p>Flavor - a lively blend of blackberry, jammy raspberry and black currant fruit mingled with black pepper and baking spice, reinforced by assertive yet balanced sweet tannins and refreshing acidity.</p>
