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The **2010 Cabernet Sauvignon** is one of the juicier wines readers will come across in this vintage. Blackberries, savory herbs, menthol, licorice and plums all take shape in the glass. **The tannins are big and enveloping, yet also sweet**, giving the wine a surprising level of accessibility given its age. There is no shortage of immediate gratification here. Anticipated maturity: 2013-2020. **Lewelling's 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Wight Vineyard** is quite a bit more polished than the straight Napa Valley bottling. **Voluptuous and inviting**, the 2010 flows across the palate with **generous dark raspberries, crushed flowers, spices and mocha, all supported by finessed, silky tannins**. Sweet floral notes are woven throughout, giving the 2010 a sense of **aromatic lift that is hugely appealing**. The Wight can be enjoyed today, but it should also age nicely in bottle. Anticipated maturity: 2013-2022. **These are two delicious, affordable Cabernets from Lewelling** and proprietor Dave Wight.
