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The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa has all that - a nice soft underbelly with finely grained, silky tannins, full body, loads of black fruits and an enticing set of aromatics. Drink it over the next 10-15 years. The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Wight ratchets up the concentration level. The fruit is deeper, denser, the wine slightly fuller-bodied, but nevertheless shares the same style of licorice, crème de cassis, cedar wood and well-integrated, subtle oak. It is a full-bodied classic from Napa that should drink nicely for 20 or more years. The poor person's Screaming Eagle? Consistently excellent wines emanate from Dave Wight under the Lewelling label. I have said this many times in the past, but they are reminescent of a classy Pauillac, such as Pontet-Canet, given their licorice and pure crème de cassis fruit.
